Mr. Billau has recently retired as a Sergeant, supervising the Forensic Investigation Section of the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab in Reno, Nevada. He has chosen to continue to provide his expertise as a forensic consultant to legal professionals and to the law enforcement community throughout the country.

Prior to serving 15 years with the Washoe County Sheriff's Office, Mr. Billau was employed with the Reno Police Department as a Crime Scene Technician and with the Glendale, California Police Department as a Senior Identification Technician.

During his career Mr. Billau has been involved in solving many high profile murder cases. He spent over a year as a member of the Hillside Strangler Task Force in Southern California.

Mr. Billau has lectured on crime scene investigation, the science of fingerprints, blood stain pattern interpretation and crime scene photography to law enforcement agencies and academies throughout California and Nevada.

Mr. Billau has testified in the area of Crime Scene Reconstruction, Blood Stain Pattern Analysis, Latent/Fingerprint Identification, Shoe and Tire Impression Evidence and Tool Mark Identification in Federal, State and Municipal Courts of Law. He has also testified before the Nevada State Senate Judiciary Committee regarding the Science of Fingerprints.
